M45 - Whitefield - Looking for a Male PA for 4 hours per week initially. It should be someone who has experience with learning difficulties and autism. Elliott is non-verbal and communicates with gestures. For the first few sessions the PA will need to spend some time with Elliott and his Mum until they get used to the idea of being separated. Elliott is very strong and will need close supervision as he does not have a good understanding of risk. He likes walking his dog, going to the cinema and bowling.

Hours are 4 per week but could increase in future. Hourly Rate is £11.44 per hour.

SK3 - Bridge Hall - Female PA is required to support client with a number of complex medical issues and mental health disorders. The client has several diagnoses, one of which is functional neurological disorder that affects her physical, cognitive, and sensory. The role requires that candidate gains an understanding the clients complex needs, then be able to support appropriate and advocate for her when necessary.

The PA will be required help the clients with all manner of daily living tasks such as personal care, dressing, medication, making meals etc, and need to undertake general household roles and responsibilities

Additionally, the PA will support the client with correspondence, carry out errands, and when necessary, support the client in attending medical appointments. Due to the nature of the mental health disorders the PA will be a permanent role, of one candidate or a job share for two, so trust and confidence can be built.

The hours are 27 per week. The Rate of pay is £12.27 per hour.

He enjoys going out to visit various national trust parks, Ikea, Cheshire oaks, etc. He would require support to go to all these places as well as food shopping and medical appointments, therefore a driver would be required. Ryan already has a small staff team in place but is looking to get some more on board. He has a number of shifts available we can discuss more in detail when meeting with Ryan. Full training will be provided for any new staff.

The current shift times are 10.30am to 2.30pm and 4pm to 8pm every day.
